The Mayor again advised that this was an operational matter.

The Clerk advised that volunteers had been contacted to attend an annual meeting, to which two people replied. As the event could not go ahead with such little interest, it was decided to possibly reschedule it in Spring. As also advised that volunteers would only be contacted once flood alerts from the Environment Agency (EA) had risen to a warning.
